ADHD and substance use disorders in adolescents and young adults: state of the art

Description:

Symposim at European Congress of Psychiatry 2023 Chair: Sandra Kooij (Netherlands), Arnt Schellekens (Netherlands)

Addictive disorders often co-occur in patients with ADHD. A recent study showed that about half of young adults with ADHD reported life time substance use disorder. Previous studies have shown that nearly one fourth of patients with substance use disorders have ADHD. Co-occurrence of these disorders negatively impacts on the prognosis and complicates treatment of both conditions. This joint symposium of the sections neurodevelopmental disorders and addictive disorders of the European Psychiatric Association will focus on recent developments in this field, specifically dealing with adolescents and young adults. Two contributions will focus on potential mechanistic explanations for the frequently observed overlap between the two conditions. Toni Ramos-Quiroga (Spain) will focus on shared heritability between ADHD and substance use disorders. Arnt Schellekens (the Netherlands) will focus on altered reward processing in both conditions. Next, clinical implications will be discussed, with Cleo Crunelle (Belgium) covering recent consensus work on adolescents with ADHD and substance use disorders of the International Collaboration on ADHD and Substance Abuse (ICASA) group. And finally, Corne Coutzee (South Africa) will share findings on protective effects of stimulant treatment on the development of addictive disorders in young adults.

How to deal with co-mortality and suicide within substance use disorders

Description: Mortality is very high in patients with substance use disorders. A broad variety of factors play a role. Among them the most important are accidents in the context of intoxications, (accidental) over dose deaths and suicide often related to additional psychiatric comorbidities, e.g. impulsivity. Also gender and the broader societal living conditions have their impact. Within the context of this workshop these different factors will be explored with respect to their causality mechanisms, impact on prevalence, recognition and possible therapeutic / preventive interventions. The latter going from broader public health approaches to attitudes and skills of individual care givers. 1. Massimo Clerici (Italy); suicidal behaviour and substance use disorders with prison populations. 3. Description: Behavioral Addictions, such as gambling disorder, video gaming disorder, or sexual addiction disorder, are classically considered within the scope of addictive disorders, which means that they resemble to substance use disorders. However, their clinical features may also look like typical psychiatric disorders, such as obsessional compulsive disorder, and their main therapeutic principles, such as cognitive & behavioral therapy, or some classes of psychotropic medications, are similar to those used in psychiatric disorders. In this joint EUFAS-EPA session, neuroscience specialists, epidemiologists, and clinicians, will address the fundamental and practical elements that may help to settle the nosological position of behavioral addictions between substance use disorders and psychiatric disorders.
