Annual Meeting - Psychopathology of crisis and uncertainty

Description:

The section of Psychopathology of the European Psychiatry Association has been active during the year 2021/2022. Our yearly meeting in Paris, taking place since 1996, has been severely affected by the Sars-COV-2 (COVID 19) pandemic but each of its members continued developing the field with Courses, Books chapters, Books, Papers and many lectures in Congresses, Seminars and Workshops. Every year, until 2020, the Section of Psychopathology have organized an annual event in a Symposium format at Salpetriérè-Paris. The participation on this Symposium is done by invitation to all section members and non-members interested in the topic chosen. In 2019 the topic was Movement Disorders in the context of clinic theory and practice under the title of Nature and Narratives of Movement Disorders; Once again the participation was high in number and quality of discussions. Participants came from UK, Austria, Italy, Nigeria, Portugal, Switzerland, Greece and France. In 2020 and 2021 for the first time in this long route the activity was cancelled by the pandemic reasons we all are aware which turn impossible the physical presence of all participants and speakers. The Symposium was substituted in 2021 by a business meeting operated by digital tools. In this business meeting all participants (12) had the opportunity to discuss again as I 2020 the section future activities, the strategy to implement and the topics to candidate to International Events, namely EPA and WPA Congresses. It was also discussed the ways to adapt the section actions to the enormous changes that this pandemia will provoke at professional and general level.

In 2022 we organised our annual meeting in Lisbon, Portugal. As usual participants came from Austria, Italy ans Switzerland. The topic was; Psychopathology of Crisis and; Uncertainty.
