## Suicidal crisis management guidelines 2022-2023

To assist informed decision-making in suicidal crisis management, a modified Delphi method has been conducted seeking opinions from clinician experts in the suicidology field to createbroad European recommendations, addressing the steps from clinical evaluation, immediate risk management, and connection tolong-term care. Thestudy was aimed at creating pragmatic recommendations for clinicians on the assessment and management of patients presenting with acute suicidal ideation or a recent suicide attempt.



The process involved two iterative rounds of surveys to assess agreement with drafted recommendations. At the beginning of 2022, a panel of 8 experts developed a number of statements. In October 2022, 150 selected psychiatrists with expertise in suicidal behaviours from across Europe were invited to express their agreement or disagreement with each of these statements and provide additional input. After receiving the answers from the initial round, the second round was launched with modified questions that did not reach the initial consensus or emerged during the first round. The process culminated in the formulation of 43 consensus recommendations approved with at least 67% agreement.

The results of the study have been published in December 2023 on the Spanish Journal of Psychiatry and Mental Health.

## Task force on National Suicide Prevention Helplines 2021 - 2023

In 2021 the Section established a task force on National Suicide Prevention Helplines.

The main objectives of the task force are:

- Exchange and systematization of current knowledge and experiences on the best modalities, efficacy and utility of national crisis helplines;
- Identify shared difficulties in the organization and delivery of such helplines, and propose solutions that could be implemented in different countries;
- Discuss the best organizational framework and specific training needs of the implicated service providers;
- Review different legislative practices across different countries and identify possible issues.



The first meeting of the task force was held on March 27, 2023 during the 31st European Congress of Psychiatry in Paris, France. During the meeting, Prof. Philippe Courtet briefly introduced the backgroud and the aims of the task force, Miriam Iosue presented an overview os suicide prevention helplines in Europe, Lucie Sharkey Plantin discussed the characteristics and impact of the recently created French nationalhelpline "3114", and Prof. Diego Palao presented the Spanish complementary numbers: 024, Esperanza and 061-emergencies. The presentations were followed by a discussion on the implications of anonimity and possible effective solutions. Possible future activities of the task force were also explored.
