Introduction:

Treatment of pregnant women essentially embraces strategies for pregnancy planning, and perinatal care, taking into consideration planning for the postpartum and breastfeeding period as well. In this session we are sharing up to date and comprehensive knowledge on the topic in order to help make rational collaborative and individualised treatment decisions concerning the prescription of psychotropic medications for common mental illnesses in the perinatal period. The course is structured to include a combination of short didactic presentations, two case-based scenarios and engaging exercise injects for group practice and discussions.

Bio

Dr. Gihan ElNahas is Professor of Psychiatry and Head of the Women's Mental Health Program Neuropsychiatry Dept-WPA Collaborate Center, at Ain Shams Medical School. Egypt. She has pioneered advancements in women's mental health through updated evidence-based guidelines for clinical education in partnership with OBG departments. She served as Mental Health Advisor for Egypt's 'Safe Women' initiative, supporting gender-based violence survivors, and edited the IAWMH's first CME-accredited course on Psychotropic Medications in Pregnancy and Lactation. She's also part of the World Psychiatric Association's women's mental health section.

Bio

Prof. Florence Thibaut is Professor of Psychiatry at the University Hospital Paris and the Paris Cité University, France. With a background in Psychiatry and Endocrinology, and a Ph.D. in Neurosciences, her expertise spans women's mental health, sexual violence, psychopharmacology, and addictive disorders.

Discriminate the level of relative safety or risk of a specific psychotropic medications in pregnancy,

Recognize and put to action rational perinatal management through joint informed decision making.

Practise the use of reliable resources of information on the reproductive safety or risk of medications.

a) Current priorities in women's mental health: Research, policy and training

Description:

This session is organised by the Section on Women's Mental Health

Increasing evidence suggests that biological sex is a fundamental modifier of biological, psychological and social mechanisms in mental illness. This suggests, that a sex-sensitive approach to mental ill health can make a significant contribution to progressing precision psychiatry. It's potential, however, is as yet under-recognized.

The first speaker, Chair of the Women's Mental Health Section of the World Psychiatric Association, will discuss salient examples of recent research in the area and priorities for future scientific enquiry. Sex/gender has been included in the EDIT Presidential Initiative of the World Psychiatric Association as one of a number of intersecting disparities. The second speaker will discuss how the WPA is planning to support a reduction of these inequalities.

The third speaker, Chair of the Council on Women's Mental Health of the American Psychiatric Association, will discuss their approach to support greater representation of women in mental health leadership positions and collaborate with other agencies to guide research and advance knowledge in the field.

Achieving progress in these areas also requires that future generations of psychiatrists receive the necessary training. The last speaker is the immediate past chair of the EPA's Section of Women's Mental Health and will discuss the opportunities offered by the planned European Board Exam for Psychiatrists to achieve this goal for women's mental health.

PROSPECTIVE NON-INTERVENTIONAL STUDY OF THE RELATIONSHIP OF PSYCHIATRIC AND GYNAECOLOGICAL FACTORS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TERMINATION OF PREGNANCY - PSYGAP. This study is aiming to evaluate the effectiveness of implementing screening for peripartum depression and establishing a clinical pathway for patients experiencing pregnancy termination and psychological distress during and after pregnancy, bridging gynecological-obstetrical and psychiatric clinics, to investigate the influence of socio-demographic and gynecological-obstetrical characteristics on the occurrence of psychopathological phenomena in women terminating pregnancies due to fetal anomalies, to assess the impact of medically indicated pregnancy termination due to fetal anomalies and voluntary pregnancy termination up to the 10th gestational week on psychological functioning, and to explore the associations between psychiatric
