EPA congress Budapest

Description:

The EPA section will held a symposium at the EPA congress in Budapest: "Controversial treatment issues in psychiatric epidemiology".

A. Mykletun's presentation will focus on causal modelling of effects of ADHD diagnosis and medication on long-term life trajectories in children and adolescents. The data source is all Norwegians aged 5-18 years who are followed up over up to 10 years for outcomes. Treatment varies between a liberal and a restrictive approach at baseline, and this variation is used a as a natural experiment. J. Kirkbride will focus on how well-equipped psychiatrists are to treat and care for refugees and asylum seekers in Europe. Drawing on survey data from 800 psychiatrists, he will explore how psychiatrists' current levels of self-rated knowledge, attitudes and skills vary by sociodemographic, clinical and geographical attributes of the workforce. Using data of the prospective population-based CoLaus|PsyCoLaus study, M.P. Strippoli will present data on the effect of antidepressant on obesity markers during a 5.5-year follow-up with adjustment for the effect of depressive episodes. The findings support unfavorable obesogenic effects of sustained treatment not only with TCAs but also with SSRIs. Relying on healthcare use data in 45- to 85-year-old participants with major depressive disorder in the same study, the presentation of M. Preisig will show important age specific differences according to use of psychiatrists or psychologists and use of psychotropic medication.
