21st EPA section congress in Lausanne

Description:

We had a very successful section symposium meeting, the 21st Congress of the EPA Section of Epidemiology and Social Psychiatry, held at the Lausanne University in Dorigny on Sept 11-14th 2024. The host of this congress was Martin Preisig and the head of the local organizing committee was Marie-Pierre Strippoli. There were 328 registered participants, of which 49% were from early career researchers. A total of 26 symposia were accepted and 204 individual abstracts were accepted (125 as oral presentations and 79 as poster presentations). We had 7 invited plenary lectures, of which one was presented by A. Mykleton on the topic "Is Under- or Over-Diagnosis of ADHD the Problem? Settling the ADHD Controversy with Causal Modelling and Population Registry Data" and one by the distinguished Professor Kathleen Merikangas from the National Institute of Mental Health, USA, entitled "Shifting the Landscape of Psychiatric Epidemiology in the Next Generation". The program was a great success in terms of the scientific quality of submissions and presentations. There were also two successful social

events, one as a wine-tasting event in the Lavaux area on the shores of Lake Geneva, and a congress dinner organized at the Olympic museum in Lausanne.

EPA congress in Budapest

Description:

The EPA section held a symposium at the EPA congress in Budapest: "Controversial treatment issues in psychiatric epidemiology". Relying on healthcare use data in 45- to 85-year-old participants with major depressive disorder in the CoLaus/PsyCoLaus study, the presentation of M. Preisig showed important age specific differences according to use of service by psychiatrists or psychologists and use of psychotropic medication. A. Mykletun's presentation focused on causal modelling of effects of ADHD diagnosis and medication on long-term life trajectories in children and adolescents. Alua Yeskendir focused on how well-equipped psychiatrists are to treat and care for refugees and asylum seekers in Europe. Using data of the prospective population-based CoLaus|PsyCoLaus study, M.P. Strippoli presented data on the effects of antidepressants on obesity markers during a 5.5-year follow-up with adjustment for the effect of depressive episodes.

EPA Congress in Madrid 2025

Description:

The EPA section will take part in the 33rd EPA Congress, Madrid, Spain, April 5-8, 2025.

The section symposium "Access to treatment and psychosocial outcome in young people with mental disorders" has been accepted. Including speakers from 3 countries, this symposium will provide information on cutting-edge epidemiological methods and results of relevant studies in young people. Dr. Robert Stewart will focus on the pertinence of the use of digital health records, which have recently become available. The use of these large data resources provides results similar to those of traditional community studies, thereby offering unprecedented opportunities for understanding course and outcome in mental health. Dr. Jennifer Dykxhoorn will present data from such primary care electronic health records in England, which support the increasing incidence of common mental disorders in young adults with demographic differences for anxiety and depression as well as growing treatment gaps. Relying on data from a nation-wide Norwegian registry, Dr. Arnstein Mikletun will show that children and adolescents referred to mental health services receive very different treatment according to controversies as to the application of diagnostic thresholds of ADHD. This results in large prognostic variance. Dr.

Martin Preisig will present data from a cohort of offspring of treated parents with bipolar and major depressive disorders in Switzerland. This prospective study revealed that the commonly reported lower psychosocial functioning in these offspring is mainly mediated by the frequent emergence of early mood psychopathology in these offspring.

Furthermore, C. Vandeleur will present an e-poster on data from a high-risk study in Lausanne on the topic of "Childhood psychopathology dimensions as predictors of mood disorders among offspring at high risk of mood and substance use disorders".

M. Preisig, A. Mykleton and C. Vandeleur will attend the EPA section coordination meeting in Madrid.
